DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

If you are in a Life Group, take some time to answer these questions before your group meets:

EPHESIANS 6:13-15

Have you ever experienced what you would call “the evil day”? If you are willing to discuss it, how did (or how would) the armor of God aid you in standing firm?

What does a failure to stand firm look like? Why is it so important to Paul that we stand firm?

Since you could spend your entire life in study and still have much to learn, how do you know when you are sufficiently “girded” with truth?

Why is righteousness likened to a breastplate? How do we practically treat it as such?

Why do you think Paul compares the preparation of the Gospel of peace to our shoes instead of something like a battle cry?

How is Gospel readiness a means of standing firm against the evil day? How are you developing and living out Gospel readiness in your life?
