What things in your life most commonly cloud the light of Christ shining through you?

Can you think of one or two people that you feel show the light of Christ particularly well? What is it about their lives that makes them stand out?

Is there a line between shining the light and being obnoxiously "Christian" all the time? (The more bumper stickers and T-shirts the better?)

Is VBC a place where the light is consistently seen and the things in darkness biblically exposed? Why or why not?

STUDY QUESTION (Optional)

Study John's teaching on light and darkness in 1 John. How does our behavior become a test of our salvation while still knowing that our salvation does not depend on works and cannot be lost?
