Are you struggling to discern what a wise course of action is for a particular decision or area in your life?

What is it about that situation that makes it hard to move forward?

What kinds of opportunities do you feel are hardest to make the most of (v. 16)?

Do you think the days are more or less evil than when Paul wrote v. 16? Does that affect how we should apply this verse today?

Should we feel guilty when we are relaxing and consuming entertainment because there are better ways to make the most of that time? Why or why not?

Do you think of God's will more as an objective and knowable thing, or as a mystical and elusive thing? How do you think Paul wants us to think about it (v. 17)?

Using a concordance or other Bible tools, find every New Testament passage that specifically describes the will of the Lord. What topics do you see addressed in these passages?
