Describe a time when you were disciplined and it turned out for your best, or a time when a parent used discipline poorly. What effect did it have on you?

How much does parenting contribute to the person a child will become? Can a child who was parented very well still have negative behaviors or attributes?

In what ways can a wife support, encourage, or equip her husband to live out this verse? What about grandparents, singles, or couples without children?
