If you are in a Life Group, take some time to answer these questions before your group meets:

EPHESIANS 6:18-20

What does it mean to be tenacious in prayer? Is it okay to stop praying for something before you see a definitive answer?

When interceding for others, is it a cop out to tack on "but Your will be done," at the end, or should we "pray in faith" with confidence that God will do as we ask in His name?

Ben challenged us on Sunday to pray on multiple "levels." What aspects of prayer do you tend to use the most, and what areas of prayer do you perhaps neglect? How can we cultivate rich, whole prayer?

In which situations do you find it easiest to share the Gospel? Which situations are the most difficult? Just as Paul overcame the challenge of prison, how can you overcome challenges to your own Gospel boldness?

Look through the different parts of the VBC Prayer (Gratitude, Godliness, Gospel, Glory) and discuss what it might look like practically if God chose to answer our prayers in each area?

In addition to what is covered in our VBC Prayer, what else do you desire to see God do in our church family?
