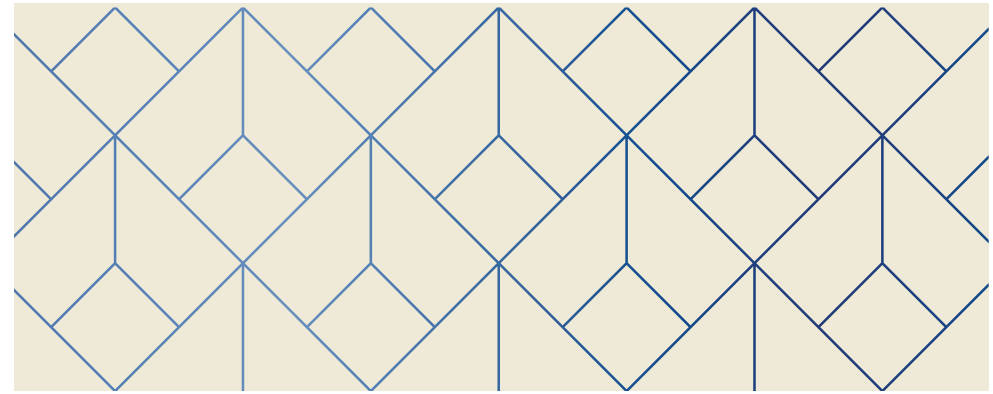
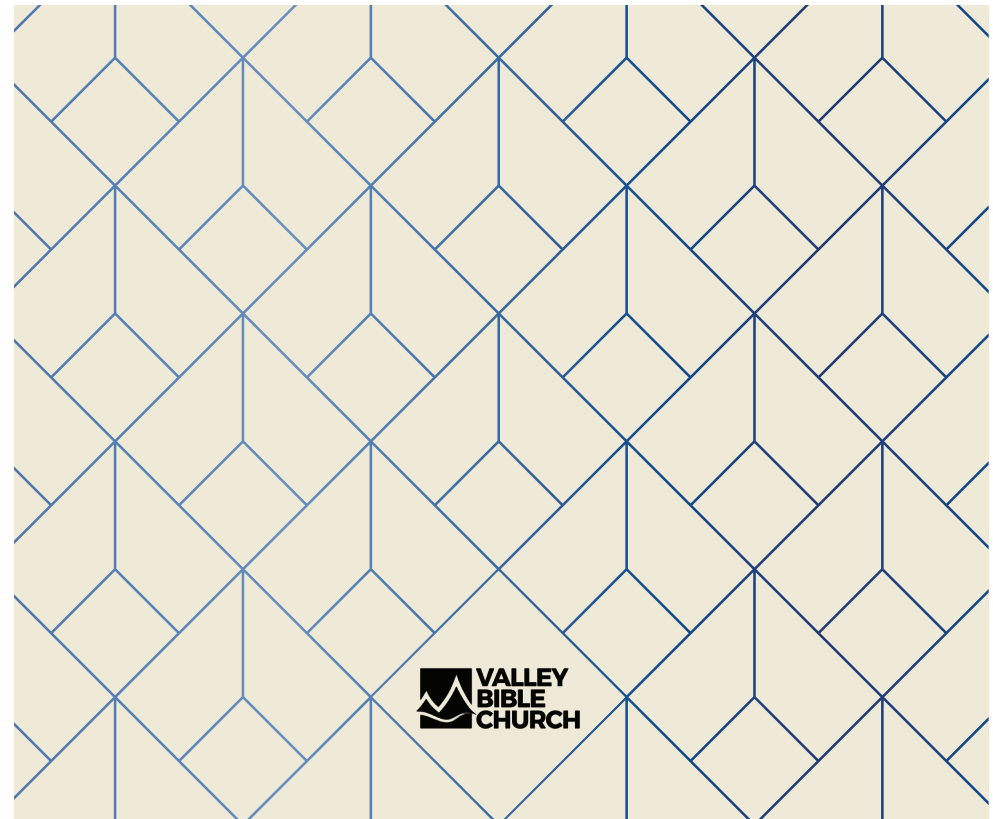


THE GOSPEL OF JOHN: John 5:25-30

5. Does the Bible allow for the belief that existence simply ends with death? How is that good news?
6. How would you respond to someone who used John 5:29 to teach good works as the means of salvation?
7. From verse 29, how do we know, specifically, what deeds are "good" or "evil", and know when we have done enough of one or the other to merit life or judgment?
8. In your experience, is the judgment of God just (vs 30)? Why or why not?
