THE GOSPEL OF JOHN: John 6:15-21


- 1. Thinking back on this week's sermon, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
- 2. The disciples were working hard to accomplish the will of Jesus (see Mark 6:45) in the middle of a storm, and grew frightened (vs 19). When (if ever) is fear an appropriate response for a Christian?
- 3. Why might God allow difficult and frightening things in the lives of believers who are following His will?
- 4. Why do you think Jesus refused to use His deity in Matthew 4, but was willing to use it to multiply fish and walk on water in John 6?
- 5. As the disciples struggled with the storm Jesus appears and immediately brings them to their destination (vs 21). Share a time when God supernaturally provided for you in a 'storm'. What did you learn, or how did you grow from this?
- 6. Have you ever experienced a storm that God did not rescue you from? What did you learn, or how did you grow, from that experience?
- 7. Should Christians expect stormy trials in their lives? What passages in Scripture support your answer?
- 8. What is something that causes you fear now, and how could you ask God for help?






