FOR THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 13

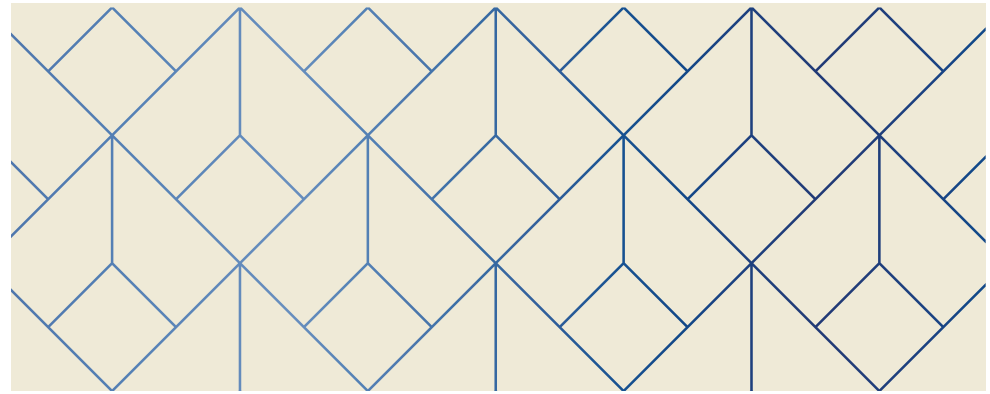
Thank you,

As we continue our emphasis on using some of the extra time afforded by the Life Group break to developing the spiritual discipline of prayer, this week's focus is on praise and adoration.

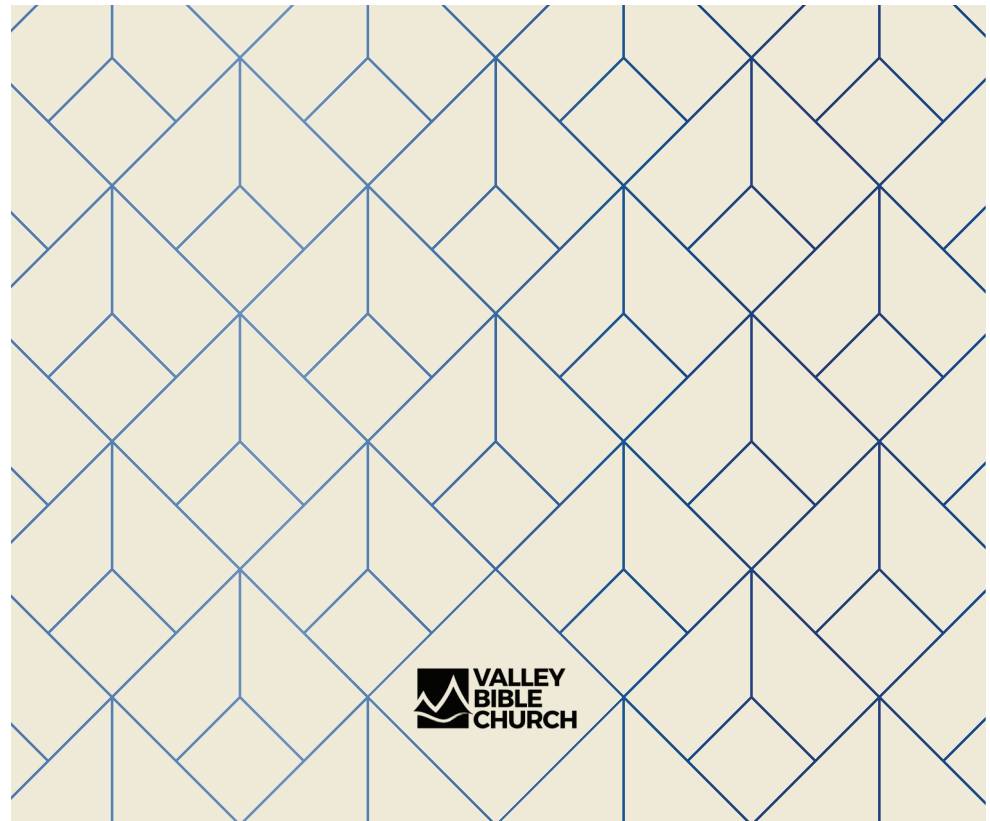
Prayer is a wonderful, powerful, and effective part of our relationship with our Lord – one that likely takes a variety of shapes in its topic, tone, and even posture. And rightly so! Yet often we can default to focusing first, or even solely, on those things we ask of God. God invites, and even commands us to make requests of Him. It is good to do so. But a conversation in which the only communication is one side asking for help is missing out on the depth a relationship is intended to have.

So, the challenge for this week is to set aside a planned amount of time just for prayers of praise and adoration. It could be five minutes or thirty, but shoot for something that is both stretching and achievable. Thank God for all that He is, all that He has done and will do, and spend time in worship before the Lord.

If you get stuck try praying through passages of Scripture (Psalm 34, 95, or 100 would make a great start) or even a favorite worship song.
