

THE GOSPEL OF JOHN: John 10:22-42

1. Thinking back on this week's sermon, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
2. Jesus' testimony about Himself in verse 25 includes both words and action. As you have shared your testimony with others have you felt more confident using words or actions? Why?
3. How does Scripture describe a believer's "eternal life" (vs 28)? Try starting with John 17:1-3.
4. Given that no one can snatch one of Jesus' sheep from His hand (vs 28, 29), of what threat is Satan to a believer?
5. Knowing that God could have used any relationship as an example, how does the earthly relationship between father and son help us to understand the statements "I and the Father are one" (vs 30) and "the Father is in Me, and I in the Father" (vs 38)?
6. Challenge yourself to list at least seven specific things for which you are grateful to God, and why. Share one with your group.
