1. Thinking back on this week's sermon, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?



- 8. In verse 49 Jesus references a command He received from the Father. In what way would it be accurate or inaccurate to say that God the Son is subordinate to God the Father?




