7. How would you respond to someone who made the claim that they can lead a healthy Christian life apart from a church?
8. How does ones' membership in things gyms, banks, grocery outlets, etc. compare to church membership?
9. What are the biblical responsibilities of God, of elders, and of members within a local church? See verses like 1 Peter 5:1-11, Acts 2:37-42, John 10:1-21, and Hebrews 10:19-25 for a head start.
