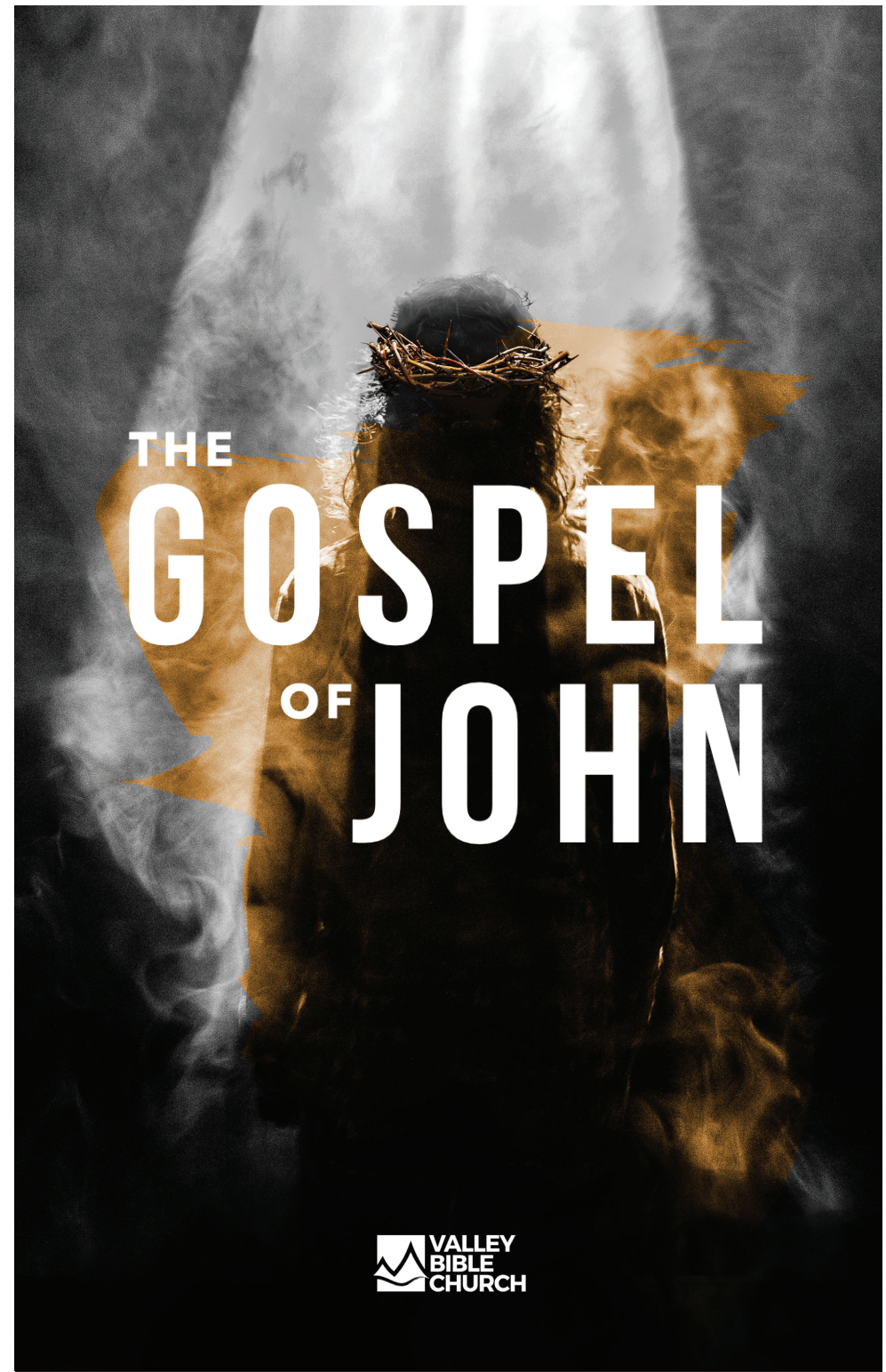


Week of October 10, 2021

5. How else is hyssop used in Scripture (see Ex. 12:21-22, Ps. 51:7, Lev. 14:1-7, Num. 19:14-19)? What impact does that have on your reading of verse 29?
6. How would you answer someone who asked of verse 30, 'What is finished?'
7. What is required of us to receive the atonement of Christ?
8. Of the people mentioned in this passage to whom do you relate most, and why?
9. How does the death of Christ impact your daily life?

Consider taking extra time in prayer as a group this week to thank Christ for what He has accomplished for you.
