
- 1. Thinking back on this week's sermon, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?

- 5. What has it cost you to follow Jesus?
- 6. After receiving his instructions, Peter then turns and asks about "the disciple whom Jesus loved" (vs 20-21). What risk is there in comparing our lives to those of others?
- 7. What benefit is there in comparing our lives to those of others?
- 8. This third week of Advent focuses on faith. Where do you find faith in our passage this week?
- 9. How has the overall study of the Gospel of John impacted your life?
