- 6. When can standing up for a biblical view of gender roles become bullying?
- 7. How can we be involved in our local community to defend and promote biblical values surrounding gender, identity, and marriage?
- 8. How, specifically, can we proactively raise the next generation (kids, grandkids, students, etc.) to value and embody biblical principles of masculinity and femininity?
