- 1. Thinking back on this week's sermon, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
- 2. Reading verses 13 and 14, what observations can you make about speaking in tongues compared to praying in tongues?
- 3. How can a person make prayer and/or singing more or less edifying for the church (vs 15)?
- 4. How does the idea of leading the worship team in song during a Sunday service make you feel? Why?
- 5. Who is the "ungifted" in verse 16?
- 6. Based on this passage is speaking in tongues something that a person can chose to do (or not do), or is it something that happens to them as a work of the Spirit?
- 7. Paul stresses the role of edification in spiritual gifts. Why, then, might Jesus have taught us to pray and act righteously in secret (Mat. 6:1-7)?
- 8. Based on this passage, when might it be appropriate or inappropriate for someone to shout "Amen!" during a worship service?
- 9. Plan something that would be edifying to someone in your sphere (family, friends, Life Group, co-workers, etc.), and commit to carrying it out this week. Share the results with your group.
