- 3. Define 'gospel' as Paul uses it in these verses.
- 4. What does it mean to "stand" in the gospel (vs 1)? What does it not mean?
- 5. How did those who lived in the Old Testament times, prior to the life of Christ and teaching of Paul, receive salvation? See verses like Psalm 2:11-12, Romans 4:3-8, Hebrews 1:1-2, and Hebrews 10:1-10.
- 6. How would you respond to someone who uses these verses to teach that it is possible to lose your salvation if you do not stand in or hold fast to your faith?
- 7. In what way is it possible to "believe in vain" (vs 2)?
- 8. How could you use this passage to engage with someone who does not attend church, but who is confident that they 'just love Jesus' or 'are spiritual'?
- 9. How can you help pass on the gospel within your spheres of influence this week?



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
