LIFE SERVICES BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN - 3 WEEKS LEFT!

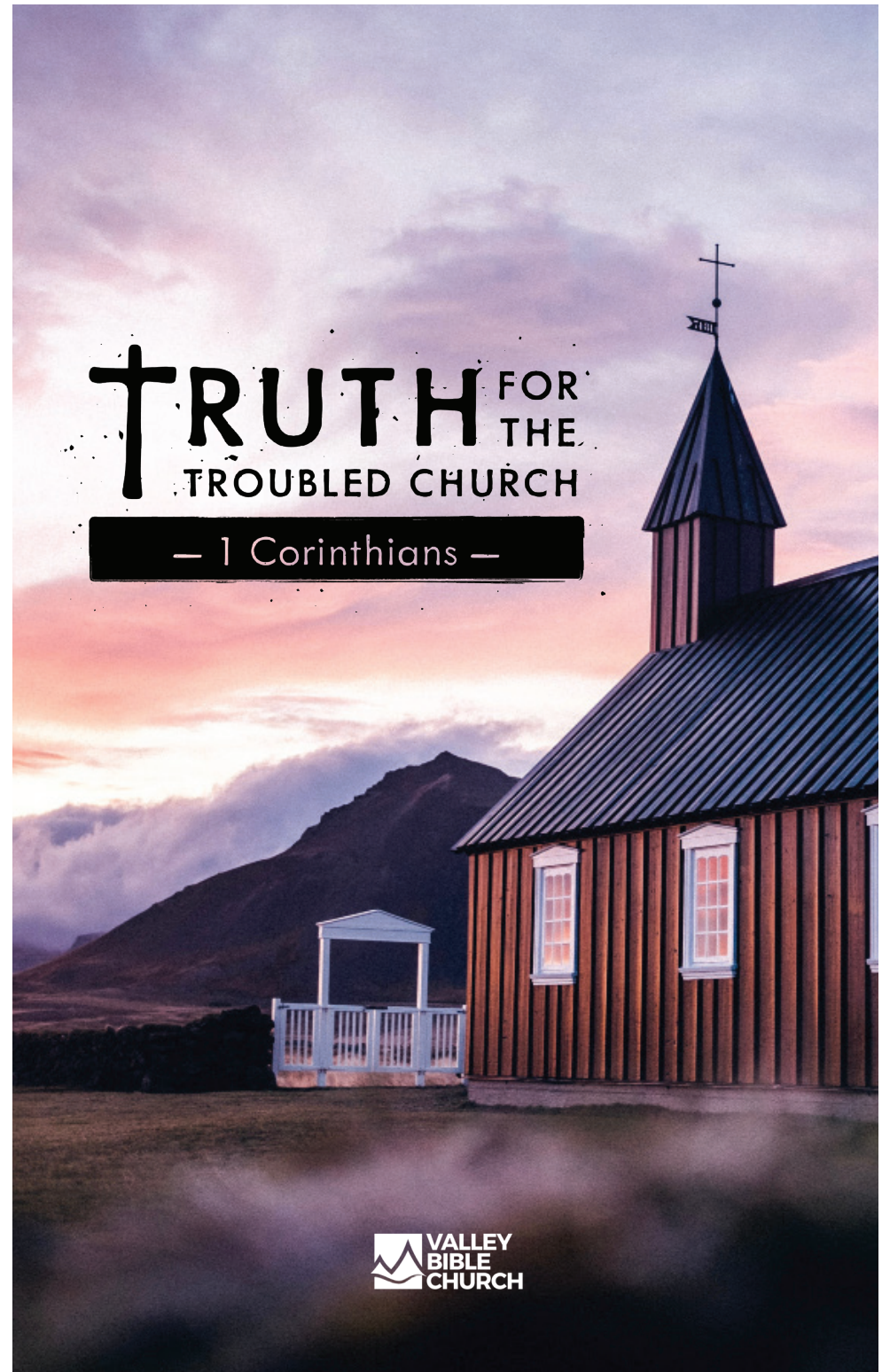
