6. Is there anyone in your life that you feel called to give biblical instruction to?
7. What sort of "fruitless" (vs 7) things distract us from "furthering the administration of God" (vs 4) today? In what ways are those things similar or different than those faced by the Ephesian church?
8. How can we tell which things are worth thinking through in detail and defending to others, and which are not?
9. Paul's goal in verse 5 is love from a pure heart, a good conscience, and sincere faith. Which of these areas do you think you need to grow in the most, and what can you do to facilitate that growth?
10. What key vocabulary in this passage do you think the Church today might not have a full or correct understanding of, and why? What about our culture?

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
