- 1. Thinking back on this week's sermon, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
- 2. List a few implications of the battle analogy Paul uses for the Christian life in verse 18.
- 3. Where do you see spiritual battlegrounds in your life right now?
- 4. Paul calls Timothy "my son" in verse 18. Do you have anyone you see as your spiritual parent or child? How had that relationship impacted your faith?
- 5. How are "faith" and "a good conscience" effective weapons in the fight Paul is describing (vs 19)?
- 6. Is Paul's condemnation of Hymenaeus and Alexander (vs 20) a contradiction of Jesus' command to "Do not judge so that you will not be judged" (Matt 7:1)? Why or why not?
- 7. What does Paul mean when he says that some have "suffered shipwreck in regard to their faith" (vs 19)? What does he *not* mean?
- 8. What lessons can we learn through the observation that Paul previously described himself as a blasphemer (vs 13), and now holds others accountable for their blasphemy (vs 20)?
