- 6. What cultural influences do you see impacting propriety and modesty the most, and in what way?
- 7. Paul says that women making a claim to godliness ought to be known by their "good works" (vs 10). As you compare the actions of Christian women to those of secular women, do you see a significant difference in their actions?
- 8. What can men do to encourage and support women as they interpret and apply these principles? In what way can they be unhelpful, or even harmful?
