

- 1. Thinking back on this week's worship service, was there anything that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?
- 2. What are the core elements of worship, and what could be considered secondary but meaningful? Examples might include singing, sermon, communion, candles and incense, etc.
- 3. What is the purpose of worship? See verses like Hebrews 12:28-29, Romans 12:1-2, Psalm 29:1-2, and Ephesians 1:3-6.
- 4. How important is the structure of a worship service (i.e. what is done, in what order, and how it is accomplished)? How does VBC achieve this well, and where could we grow?
- 5. What stood out to you while listening to the testimonies given, and why might it have affected you the way it did?
- 6. How can you prepare your body, mind, and heart for worship?
- 7. How many of the 'one another' commands in Scripture are accomplished through Sunday worship?
- 8. Why is song such an integral part of worship? Verses like Ps. 28:7, Ps. 150:1-6, Jas. 5:13, and Eph 5:19 might be helpful.
