



#### **ONLINE GIVING CLARIFICATION**

We want to clarify some questions that have come up about online giving. We are able to take credit card payments, but it does cost the church a significant transaction fee. If you wish to minimize this fee, there are two options. If you choose to use a credit card, you can check a box that says "offset our costs by 3%" at the bottom of the VBC giving page (<code>spokanevbc.org/giving-home</code>). This will send the full amount of your donation to the church and charge your card for the extra fees. Or, if you are able, you can set up giving through ACH payments. This establishes a direct payment between your bank and the church, and the fees are dramatically less.
