Vacation Bible School is July 22-26! We are still looking for a PreK Teacher and Lower Elementary Assistant/Co-Teacher.

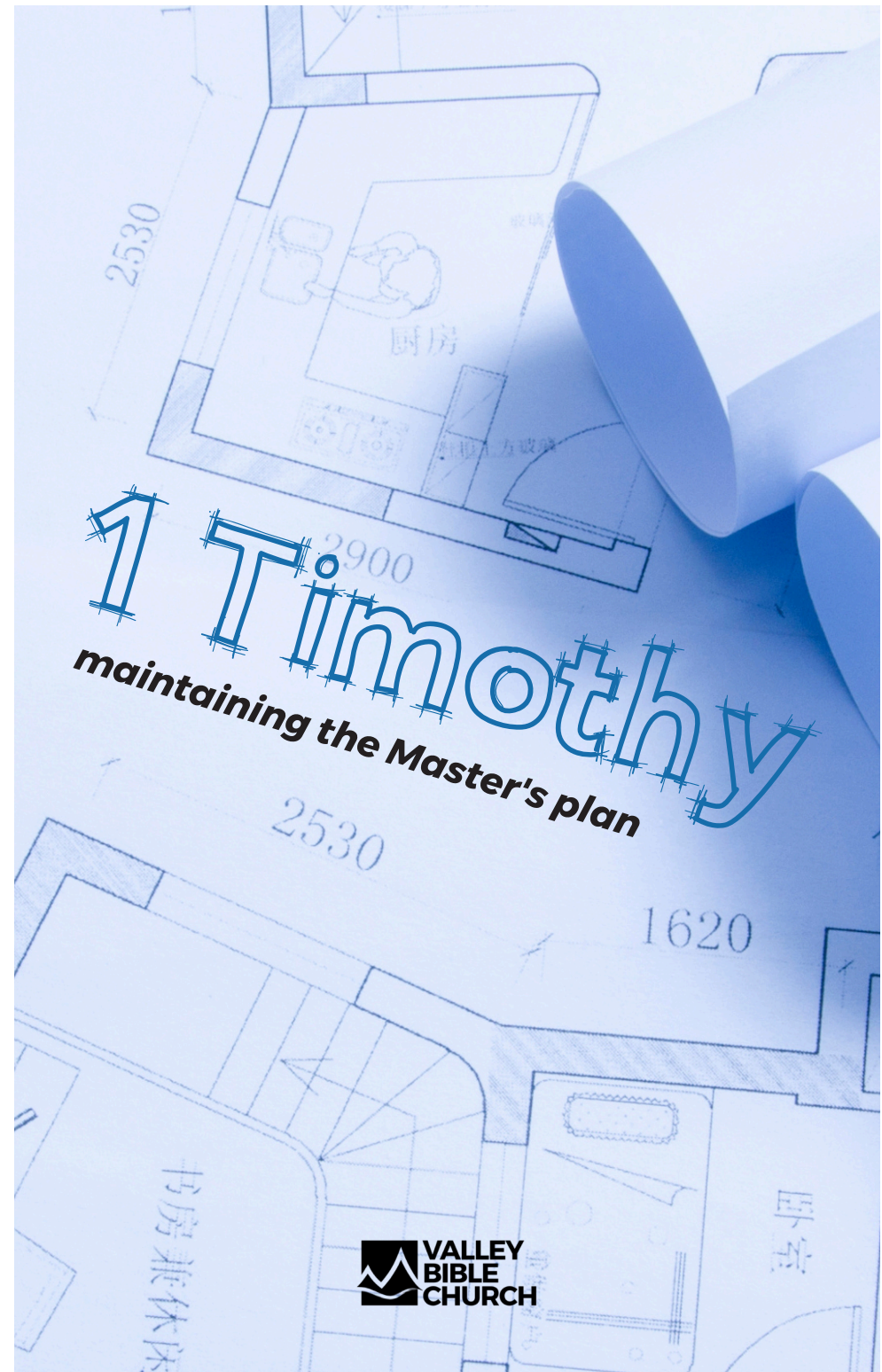
