ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

- *A Survey of Old Testament History.* We will overview the Old Testament (OT) historical books from Genesis to Esther. We will look at the flow and continuity of the OT, understand its underlying purpose, and see how knowing the OT is foundational to fully understanding the New Testament. Taught by Dr. Mike Powell in Room 130A.

- *Doctrine of Salvation: from Eternity Past to Eternity Future.* In this class, we will explore what Scripture teaches about our salvation from our election in the past to our glorification in the future. Along the way, we will consider such questions as: What is salvation? Why do we need it? How do we obtain it? What is the basis of God's choice of individuals for salvation? What happens at salvation? Can salvation be lost? Can we have assurance of our salvation? What is justification and sanctification? Is saving faith a gift from God or man's contribution? What is grace? What about the Lordship Controversy? How do works fit in? What about human free will and responsibility? What is the atonement? Join us as we investigate our so great salvation.
