1. Thinking back on this week's message, was there anything you heard for the first time or that caught your attention, challenged, or confused you?

2. Summarize chapter 1 in your own words – ideally in a single sentence. What is the main point the author is making? Next, what is one takeaway from chapter 1 you have applied to your life, or that has affected your thinking? Share with your group!

3. In verse 1, the author gives a warning – “we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard.” What is being referred to? What have “we heard”? This may require a little research – grab a study Bible or commentary!

4. The warning in verse 1 can also be applied more broadly – we must pay careful attention to the words of Scripture so that we do not drift away. How have you seen this play out in your life? Can you think of a time when you “drifted” due to not paying careful attention to the words of Scripture?

Don't Disregard the \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_ (3b-4)

5. “Drifting” is a very real danger in today's world – we live in a culture filled with distractions. What routines, disciplines, or habits have you built into your life to help guard against the tendency to drift? Share with your group!

6. In verse 2, the “word spoken through the angels” refers to the Mosaic law, which in Jewish tradition was said to have been “given by angels.” According to verses 2-3, are believers today still subject to the Mosaic law?

7. According to verse 4, God affirmed the validity of his message, delivered through the apostles, by “signs and wonders and various miracles and by gifts of the Holy Spirit.” Where else in Scripture do we see God using miracles to confirm that a message is indeed from Him?

8. What is one thing you are applying to your life as a result of studying this passage?
