IMPORTANT ONLINE GIVING UPDATE

Valley Bible Church is switching its online giving platform from Vision2 to Planning Center. Vision2 is ceasing operation, so we needed to find another solution. Fortunately, we already use Planning Center for most areas of church life, including Children's Check-In, event registration, Life Groups, and the church directory. Using Planning Center for online giving will help keep everything in one place.

The best way to use Planning Center Online Giving is to log in to your existing Church Center account at *valleybible.churchcenter.com/login*. You can do this on the Church Center website or by downloading the Church Center app (*valleybible.churchcenter.com/setup*). When you log in using your phone number or email address, a code will be sent to you as a one-time password. Once you have logged in, click "Give" on the top menu bar, which will allow you to select your giving frequency (either a one-time gift or regular giving).


