STUDY QUESTIONS

Week of Oct. 26, 2025

1. Thinking back on this week's message, was there anything that encouraged, challenged, or confused you? Anything you disagreed with or had never heard before?
2. In verse 13, Paul exhorts Timothy to do something in a certain way. What is Timothy to do, and in what way is he to do it?
3. "Sound words" is another way of saying "correct doctrine" or "right theology." Throughout church history, Christians have used tools like creeds and catechisms to help pass along "sound words" to the next generation. In what way were the sound words of doctrine passed down to you? What were the benefits or drawbacks of the way you were taught?
4. In verse 14, Paul is instructing Timothy to guard "the treasure which has been entrusted to you." What has been entrusted to Timothy? And by whom was it entrusted to him?
5. Also in verse 14, Paul instructs Timothy to "Guard, through the Holy Spirit..." What is being instructed here? What would Timothy have needed to do in response to this instruction?
6. It seems likely that Paul is discouraged as he writes this letter – perhaps severely. Most of his close compatriots have left, he is imprisoned, winter is approaching. Though Paul was an apostle, we should remember he was merely human like us. What lessons can we take from this passage, or from Paul's other writings, as to how a Christian should respond to a season of discouragement?
7. We should not walk away from a study of any passage of Scripture without it impacting our lives in some way. What is one way your thinking and/or actions have changed as a result of studying this passage?




