



STUDY QUESTIONS

Week of Jan. 11, 2026

1. Thinking back on this week's message, was there anything that encouraged, challenged, or confused you? Anything you disagreed with or had never heard before?
2. Paul turns now to some personal comments and requests; in some ways, it's might seem a bit odd for these items to be inspired by the Holy Spirit and included in Scripture. Why do you think God included these verses in his book?
3. What can we learn about Paul's character as a minister and servant of God from his words this passage?
4. In verse 10, Paul calls out a man named Demas for "having loved this present world." Why is that a big deal? Aren't we as Christians called to love and steward God's creation? What sin is Paul getting at?
5. Following up on question 3, how can we today avoid the sin of "loving this present world"? What is it we are called to do instead? And what practically might this look like in your life over the next week?
6. We should not walk away from a study of any passage of Scripture without it impacting our lives in some way. What is one way your thinking and/or actions have changed as a result of studying this passage?
