STUDY QUESTIONS

Week of Feb. 15, 2026

1. Thinking back on this week's message, was there anything that encouraged, challenged, or confused you? Anything you disagreed with or had never heard before?
2. Though we technically began chapter 2 last week, take some time this week to review chapter 1, and summarize it in a single sentence. What is the author's main point? Keep a record of these summaries as we go through the book!
3. In verse 3, the Greek word translated "know" is *ginōskō*, but its full meaning doesn't come across clearly in the English. This is one of John's favorite words, and it'll come up often as we go through the book. Use your study Bible or online resource to do a word study of this term and write out a brief definition.
4. Verses 3-6 might seem concerning to us – is John teaching that our salvation is at stake if we do not obey God's law? Since none of us can perfectly imitate Jesus (verse 6), can any of us have assurance of salvation?
5. What is the "old commandment" to which John refers here? Though John doesn't explicitly define it here, he does in one of his other epistles. Check out 2 John to read the author explain this "old commandment" further, and write out a definition for yourself.
6. John summarizes the point he's making in verses 3-6 with his reference to the "old commandment." In other words, following the "old commandment" (as defined in 2 John) summarizes his exhortation to imitate Christ and follow God's commandments. Where else do we see God's law spoken of this way? How ought this understanding influence the way we approach rules and discipline in our families? Or discipleship in our church?
7. We should not walk away from a study of any passage of Scripture without it impacting our lives in some way. What is one way your thinking and/or actions have changed as a result of studying this passage?

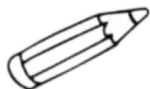
