STUDY QUESTIONS

Week of May 31, 2026

1. Since this is the last life group meeting of the session, spend some time this week planning a summer hangout or two to keep in touch over the off season!
2. Thinking back on this week's message, was there anything that encouraged, challenged, or confused you? Anything you disagreed with or had never heard before?
3. Both John and Jesus make a connection between hatred and murder. How are these two things connected? In what way is hatred like murder?
4. This passage reminds us that we are to love one another, and that the world is going to hate us. Are we to hate the world? Why or why not? Defend your answer using what we've studied so far in 1 John!
5. What are some practical ways you have sought to "love the brethren"? If you were explaining to a new believer how to do this well, what kinds of examples would you use?
6. What are some practical ways you have sought to love those who are not of us (unbelievers)? In what ways is that love similar to the love we ought to have for believers? In what ways is it different?
7. Since this is our last week of life groups before the end of the session, take some time this week to read through the rest of 1 John. What are some things coming up that you are particularly looking forward to studying? What questions do you have about upcoming passages? Share with your group, and perhaps ask your life group leader to pass them along to the elders – it's always helpful for those preaching God's word to know what questions God's people have!
8. We should not walk away from a study of any passage of Scripture without it impacting our lives in some way. What is one way your thinking and/or actions have changed as a result of studying this passage?

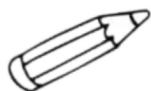
